Distinguished Teaching & Learning Award (DTLA) In Recognition of Exemplary Teaching Technique, Practice, or Activity

Spring 10	
January – February	Collect faculty nominations
March – April	<p>Review process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DTLA committee for each division meets and reviews nomination forms and selects finalists for DTL Award. <p>Selection process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DTLA committee for each division meets with finalist and each finalist presents a 10-15 minutes presentation, discussion, or demonstration of their teaching technique, practice, or activity. Committee selects up to three faculty members to receive DTL award. It is recommended that one faculty (out of three) be recognized for their innovative online teaching practices.
April 30	<p>Submission of Information to the AVP for Academic Affairs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chair of the DTLA committee for each division submits up to three faculty names that have been selected to receive DTL award. Chair also submits DTLA Nomination Form (available on DTLA webpage) about the exemplary teaching practice for each faculty selected to receive DTL award.
May 15	All documents are submitted to the Office of the Assistant to the Vice President (AVP) for Academic Affairs.
June - July	The office of the AVP for Academic Affairs will order the awards for faculty members that have been selected by the division DTLA nomination committee.
Fall 10	
August 2009	During the Faculty Professional Developing Day in the beginning of the Fall semester the DTLA recipients will be announced and awards will be presented to the DTLA award winners.
October 2009	The Public Relations Office will show case each DTL award recipient on the DTL webpage in the Hall of Fame section.
