1. Requirement of MATH 1324 – Mathematics for Business & Social Sciences for the Mathematics Elective – Core Curriculum

Justification: The Business Administration department is requesting the change as part of the recently approved Texas Transfer Framework field of study from THECB. Beginning Fall 2023, MATH 1324 will be a requirement for the Mathematics Elective – Core Curriculum component.

2. Revision of credit hours to ACCT 2401 – Principles of Financial Accounting from 4 semester credit hours to 3 semester credit hours.

Justification: The proposed change is to align with the recent THECB Field of Study mandated changes that affect the current semester credit hours.
