- SPCH 1311 INTRODUCTION TO SPEECH COMMUNICATION**
Prerequisite: Completion of READ 80 or equivalent.
- COSC 1301 MICROCOMPUTER APPLICATIONS**
Prerequisite: Reading 80 or equivalent.
- HIST 1301 UNITED STATES HISTORY I**
Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores.
- ENGL 1301 COMPOSITION**
Prerequisite: Completion of READ 80 or equivalent. A passing score of 220+ on the writing portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores.
- HIST 1302 UNITED STATES HISTORY II**
Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores.
- ENGL 1302 COMPOSITION II - RHETORIC**
Prerequisite: A grade of "C" or higher in ENGL 1301. A passing score of 220+ on the writing portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores.
- MATH 1414 COLLEGE ALGEBRA**
Prerequisite: A passing score of 250+ on the math portion of the TASP test or completion of MATH 1332 or MATH 1324 with a grade of "C" or better; or qualify for the "B or Better" option; or TASP exemption via SAT, ACT, or TAAS scores.
- MATH 2412 PRECALCULUS ALGEBRA AND TRIGONOMETRY**
Prerequisite: MATH 1414 with a grade of "C" or better.
- MATH 2413 CALCULUS I**
Prerequisite: MATH 2412 with a grade of "C" or better.
- SPAN 2313 SPANISH FOR SPANISH SPEAKERS I**
Prerequisite: None.
- SPAN 1311 BEGINNING SPANISH I - NON SPANISH SPEAKERS**
Prerequisite: Departmental placement exam required.
- PHYS 1415 PHYSICAL SCIENCE I (recommended)**
Prerequisite: Pass the reading section of the TASP test or completion of READ 90, pass the MATH section of the TASP test or completion of MATH 90 with a grade "C" or better.
- BIOL 1408 GENERAL BIOLOGY I**
Prerequisite: Pass the reading section of the TASP test or completion of READ 90 with a grade of "C" or better.
- GOVT 2301 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT I**
Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores.
- MATH 1350 FUNDAMENTALS OF MATHEMATICS I**
Prerequisite: MATH 1414.
- PHIL 2303 INTRODUCTION TO LOGIC**
Prerequisite: Eligible for ENGL 1301.
- PHYS 1417 PHYSICAL SCIENCE II (recommended)**
Prerequisite: PHYS 1415 with a grade of "C" or better.
- BIOL 1409 GENERAL BIOLOGY II**
Prerequisite: BIOL 1408 with a grade of "C" or better.
- GOVT 2302 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT II**
Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the TASP test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or TASP exemption via SAT or ACT scores. Recommended completion of GOVT 2301.

Prerequisite: MATH 1350.
