Prerequisite: Completion of READ 80 or equivalent; and a passing score of 220+ on writing portion of the THEA test, or completion of ENGL 91 with a grade of "C" or better, or THEA exemption via SAT or ACT scores.

COSC 1301 MICROCOMPUTER APPLICATIONS

Prerequisite: Successful completion of READ 90 or equivalent.

HIST 1302 UNITED STATES HISTORY II

Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the THEA test, or completion of READ 90 with a grade of "C" or better, or THEA exemption via SAT, ACT, or TAKS scores.

ENGL 1302 COMPOSITION II - RHETORIC

Prerequisite: A grade of "C" or higher in ENGL 1301. A passing score of 220+ on the writing portion of the THEA test or qualify for the "B or Better" option or THEA exemption via SAT or ACT scores.

MATH 1414 COLLEGE ALGEBRA

Prerequisite: A passing score of 250+ on the math portion of the THEA test; or completion of MATH 1332 or MATH 1324 with a grade of "C" or better; or THEA exemption via SAT, ACT, or TAKS scores.

MATH 2412 PRECALCULUS ALGEBRA AND TRIGONOMETRY

Prerequisite: MATH 1414 with a grade of "C" or better.

MATH 2413 CALCULUS I

Prerequisite: MATH 2412 with a grade of "C" or better.

PHIL 1301 INTRODUCTION TO PHILOSOPHY

Prerequisite: Eligible for ENGL 1301.

GOVT 2301 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT I

GOVT 2302 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT II

Recommended: Completion of GOVT 2301.*

Prerequisite: HIST 1301 and HIST 1302.

HIST 2328 MEXICAN AMERICAN HISTORY II

Prerequisite: A passing score of 230+ on the reading portion of the THEA test, or completion of READ 90 with a grade of "C" or better, or THEA exemption via SAT, ACT, or TAKS scores.
