

## STCC Faculty Senate Passes Resolution

At the Faculty Senate meeting of February 17, 2000, faculty presented the following resolution (Resolution B) to general assembly to be voted on by all full-time faculty. Thereafter, voting took place on February 22, 2000, and ballot boxes were available to all full-time faculty during Professional Development Day. Consequently, full-time faculty overwhelmingly endorsed Resolution B. 160 people voted, with 154 faculty supporting Resolution B, and 6 opposed. According to the Faculty Senate Constitution, Senate Resolutions will be submitted to STCC president Dr. Shirley Reed and the STCC Board of Trustees.

### *Resolution B*

The South Texas Community College Faculty Senate believes full pedagogical authority should be vested in faculty. Thus, in accordance with SACS criteria, faculty should exercise governance over student-related issues and the educational process.

The Faculty at South Texas Community College therefore requests that the administration and the Board of Trustees to also endorse Resolution B.
