Timeline Summary

Time Period	Activity
April 2017	College-wide informational sessions regarding program clusters; describing the purpose of clusters and the implications for the student experience Presentations have taken place at the following meetings – Faculty Senate, Instructional Division Meetings, ATD Coaches Meeting, Summit on College Readiness, Dual Credit Update, and several department meetings.
May 2017	Identification of faculty lead representative from each instructional division and formation of a cross-divisional Program Cluster Development Committee.
Summer 2017	Research on program clusters models conducted by faculty lead representatives and Program Cluster Development Committee.
September - October 2017	Departments/Programs discuss provided program cluster samples and make recommendations on how programs should be clustered. Due by October 27th.
October - November 2017	Cluster Teams, consisting of Chairs and/or Assistant Chairs and/or Program Coordinators and/or Lead Faculty representing each of the programs in their respective cluster, will be formed and review the feasibility of their proposed program cluster, making any further recommendations on how their programs should be clustered. Due by November 15th.
November – December 2017	All recommendations will be discussed by core Pathways Team. From submitted models, Pathways Team will finalize various proposals to be considered and discussed at the December College Wide Curriculum Committee. Due by December 1st.
Spring 2018	The College-Wide Curriculum Committee will vote for the final Program Cluster Proposal.

	Researching how program clusters can be implemented within Banner and DegreeWorks.
Spring 2018*	<p>Programs engage in program mapping – course sequencing (including developmental coursework), identification of critical courses, and identification of the “right math.” Review of first-term (or first 15-20 hours) of coursework within program clusters for alignment.</p> <p>Development of an overall student support structure for students enrolled in the program clusters (advising, career exploration, progress monitoring from entry to graduation).</p>
Fall 2018 & Early Spring 2019	Submission of curriculum revisions as needed for implementation in the 2019-2020 College Catalog. Revision of college website to reflect program clusters. Inclusion of program clusters in Banner and DegreeWorks for Fall 2019 registration.

*Additional time may be needed for mapping of all programs. In this case, implementation of Program Clusters may be delayed to take place ahead of Fall 2020 registration.
