


Blackboard – Course Evaluation

Purpose

Blackboard allows you to add the Smart Evaluation tool link for course evaluations within the course by following this instruction guide for original course experience and ultra course experience.

Step 1: Log in to Blackboard: <https://southtexascollege.blackboard.com/>

Step 2: Select **Courses** from left side menu:




Ultra Course Experience

Step 1: Click the “+” to add the Course Evaluation tool link.


Step 2: Select “*Content Market*” from the drop down menu.




Step 3: From the Content Market list, select the “*Course Evaluation*” by clicking on the “+”
