1	Jan. 22- Feb. 1	Student	Activate – Student emails and update Starfish profiles
2	Jan. 22- Feb. 1	Faculty	Create/update – Faculty update Starfish profiles and office hours, including location
3	Jan. 24 – Jan. 28	Faculty	Verify – First Week Attendance Roster Verification
4	Jan. 31 – Feb. 6	Faculty	Clear Flags – Attendance Roster Verification
5	Feb. 11 – Mar. 1	Faculty	Progress Survey #1 – Submit 1st Survey (Wks. 4-6)
6	Mar. 25 – Apr. 12	Faculty	Progress Survey #2 – Submit 2 nd Survey (Wks.10-12)

*NOTE: Starfish will be available to faculty throughout the semester.

Activity 1: During the first two weeks: Student Instructions will be provided for the following: how to activate their JagMail, update their Starfish profiles, and use the "raise your hand" icon in the Starfish portal.

Academy Programs staff will assist students to activate/update their profiles.

- **Activity 2:** During the first two weeks: Faculty will create and/or update their Starfish profile, which includes their office hours, campus location, and office number.
- **Activity 3:** During week 1 of the semester: Faculty will verify the First Week of Attendance (Attendance Roster Verification) using Starfish.
- Activity 4: During week 2 of the semester: Faculty will revisit the attendance roster verification flags to clear flags for any students who <u>are now attending class</u> and clear any "Raised Hand" flags.
- Activity 5: During weeks 4-6 of the semester: Progress survey #1 will be launched. Faculty will be prompted to raise **DE Academy** flags for students who are "in danger of failing", or who have "attendance issues".

 *If no academic or attendance concerns, please provide kudos by selecting "**DE Academy Earning an A**" or "**DE Academy Earning a B**"
- Activity 6: During week 10-12 of the semester: Progress survey #2 will be launched. Faculty will be prompted to raise **DE Academy** flags for students who are "in danger of failing", or who have "attendance issues". In addition, if the previous flags raised during week 6 have been addressed, please use this opportunity to clear those flags.
