



# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between SOUTH TEXAS COLLEGE and TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY – CORPUS CHRISTI Re: BACHELOR OF ARTS IN THEATRE

This Agreement is entered into upon the final signature date between Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi ("TAMU-CC") and South Texas College.

### 1) **Purpose of Agreement:**

The purpose of this agreement is to enable students who successfully complete the General Associate Degree at South Texas College to gain credit for the corresponding courses in the requirements for the Bachelor of Arts in Theatre degree at TAMU-CC. This document will also establish equivalencies, where appropriate, between courses in the Theatre programs taught at both locations to ensure students may secure credit for a given course at either location. Equivalencies will be reviewed each year by both institutions and revisions attached as appendices, as well as, updated in the Unofficial Sample Transfer Guides.

### 2) Terms of Agreement:

## A. Equivalent Courses at TAMU-CC and South Texas College

Appendices 1 through 3 are the Unofficial Sample Transfer Guides as follows:

Appendix 1 – Bachelor of Arts Theatre (Acting/Directing) Appendix 2 – Bachelor of Arts Theatre (Design/Tech) Appendix 3 – Bachelor of Arts Theatre (EC-12 Teacher Certification)

# **B.** For students obtaining a general Associate degree at South Texas College desiring credit toward a BA Theatre degree at TAMU-CC:

Students who obtain a general Associate degree at South Texas College at least one semester prior to completing the requirements for a BA degree at TAMU-CC will be considered as completing the required "core" courses at TAMU-CC.

# C. For a student desiring to transfer from South Texas College to TAMU-CC for the BA degree:

For admission to the BA curriculum, the student must have a minimum grade point average of at least 2.0 for all coursework taken and a minimum grade point average of 2.0 in all theatre classes undertaken. Credit for individual courses is determined as described below.

BA graduates at TAMU-CC are required to have completed at least 45 student credit hours in upper-level courses (3xxx or 4xxx) from the BA degree curriculum. No coursework from South Texas College general Associate degree is considered an upper-level course at TAMU-CC.

# D. For students seeking credit at TAMU-CC toward a BA program for classes taken at South Texas College:

Credit at TAMU-CC will be granted for courses wherein a grade of "C" or better was obtained at South Texas College.

If a South Texas College student transfers to TAMU-CC and does not obtain a general Associate degree at South Texas College, the student will be required to complete all core curriculum requirements as listed in the BA degree plan at TAMU-CC. Courses at South Texas College, not in the South Texas College core curriculum for the general Associate degree, may be used as credit for core curriculum courses at TAMU-CC.

# E. For students seeking credit for courses in the general Associate curriculum at South Texas College for courses taken at TAMU-CC:

Courses taken at TAMU-CC in which a grade of "C" or better was obtained will be granted credit for equivalent courses a South Texas College.

# F. All students majoring in theatre must have a successful audition as described in the TAMU-CC course catalog, and is a requirement of program acceptance at TAMU-CC.

3) Term of Agreement: This Agreement shall become effective upon final signature of this agreement, and shall continue for a term not to exceed 5 years. A new agreement shall need to be executed prior to expiration of the  $5^{th}$  year to continue the program. It may be modified by written agreement signed by authorized officials from both institutions.

4) **Termination:** Upon implementation, this agreement will continue on an annual basis until one of the institutions petition the other to end the agreement. The agreement will be reviewed by both institutions annually prior to the beginning of the fall semester and updated as necessary. Should the agreement be terminated, students in-progress will be allowed a one-year transfer grace period to fulfill the requirements under the articulation agreement.

A petition to end this agreement must be submitted in writing, signed by the President or Provost of the institution making the petition, and delivered to the other party to the agreement.

5) Notices: Any notice required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be deemed to be delivered (whether actually received or not) when deposited with the United State Postal Service, postage prepaid, certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the intended recipient at the address set out below. Notice may also be given by regular mail, personal delivery, courier delivery, facsimile transmission, email or other commercially reasonably means and will be effective when actually received. TAMU-CC and South Texas College can change their respective notice address by sending to the other party a notice of the new address. Notices should be addressed as follows:
