Executive Summary

1. Provide a full complement of nursing education programs, Master's in business and technology, and Healthcare Learning Innovations' training courses for **South Texas College** affiliates that are consistent; all from one university dedicated to the healthcare industry:

Bachelor of Science in Nursing completion program (RN to BSN) Master of Science in Nursing degree program, with five specializations (MSN) Accelerated RN to BS/MS in Nursing degree program (RN to BSN/MSN) Doctor of Nursing Practice degree program, with four specializations (DNP) Infection Prevention and Control Certificate (graduate level) Business and Technology degrees at the Master level Healthcare Learning Innovations training courses (60-90 minutes each)

- 2. Provide a special tuition structure that helps **South Texas College** affiliates utilize their tuition dollars cost-effectively and efficiently.
- 3. Provide **South Texas College** graduates with automatic acceptance into American Sentinel's nursing programs.
- 4. Provide a Tuition deferment program for **South Texas College** faculty allowing for employees, who are interested and if eligible, to take advantage of any applicable employer tuition reimbursement benefits.

5. Create and execute communication plan with senior leadership.

Why American Sentinel University?

We are uniquely positioned to offer features that can be advantageous for **South Texas College.** These features include:

- Accredited healthcare focused university with Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) accredited bachelor and master nursing programs.
- Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) accredited DNP degree program (DNP Executive Leadership, DNP Educational Leadership, DNP Informatics Leadership, DNP Professional Leadership).
- 100% online platform (no campus or classrooms, engage weekly at student's convenience; except in the DNP residency).
- ADN /ASN/nursing diploma provides 60 transfer credits and up to 30 hours for general education elective courses in our BSN program.
- Early Admission Program to begin the RN to BSN program prior to passing the NCLEX-RN.

- Prior college and work experience can fast-track degree with transfer credits.

Concurrent Admissions Agreement

- 1. This Concurrent Admissions Agreement, also known as Dual Enrollment Agreement, is made by and between American Sentinel University and **South Texas College** in support of students attending **South Texas College**.
- 2. The purpose of this agreement is to provide opportunities for students attending **South Texas College** to increase the depth of study, broaden educational opportunities, and to shorten the time necessary for a student to complete their requirements of the post-secondary degree by participating in the program.
- 3. The Concurrent Admissions Agreement is a program that allows for the enrollment of eligible South Texas College students to be dually enrolled students. Students must enroll at the beginning of their third semester at South Texas College while obtaining an Associate degree or credits to be transferred toward an American Sentinel University baccalaureate degree program.
- 4. A Concurrent Admissions student is a student who is simultaneously enrolled at both **South Texas College** and American Sentinel University and the credits earned at **South Texas College** may be eligible to be transferred into the RN to BSN baccalaureate program at American Sentinel University.
- 5. To meet eligibility requirements for participation in the Concurrent Admissions Agreement/Dual Enrollment Agreement, associate degree eligible students must:
 - a. Provide proof of enrollment in an eligible Associate of Nursing degree program.
 - b. Have a minimum 2.0 GPA.
 - c. Must be in their 3^{rd} semester of coursework or completed **30** semester hours.
 - d. Have achieved good academic standing with -South Texas College.
- 6. Students who meet these requirements will receive:
 - a. A letter stating conditional acceptance into the American Sentinel University Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program.

- b. Admissions and Academic Advising.
- 7. While in the Concurrent Admissions/Enrollment courses, students shall be required to comply with all applicable American Sentinel University policies and procedures which normally apply to all American Sentinel University students.

Premium Features for South Texas College Affiliates:

1. Accelerated admissions for nursing programs

Graduates of **South Texas College** who meet the minimum GPA requirement for admission are automatically accepted.

Required documentation for all enrolling students includes the following:

- Application for admission (online application)
- Resumé
- Official copy of Associate and/or Bachelor of Science and/or Master of Science transcripts
- Copy of active/unencumbered RN license (nursing degree programs; except <u>f</u>or Early Admissions Program as described in above section.

Applications will receive a 24-hour turnaround. Transcripts will be evaluated within 72 hours for additional transfer credit possibilities.

3. Tuition Deferment Program

If a tuition reimbursement program is in place at **South Texas College**, participating faculty/employees must sign a promissory note with American Sentinel University. Tuition is due thirty (30) days after

each course is completed. Tuition deferment is only available if **South Texas College** provides financial educational assistance to employees.

4. American Sentinel University Reporting to South Texas College Management

To comply with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the Department of Education's response to HIPAA, American Sentinel can provide student progress reporting to **South Texas College** management if each affiliate completes a third-party release form. Upon request, American Sentinel University will provide an annual progress summary of all affiliates of South Texas College.

5. Family Benefits

To enhance the value of our educational partnership, American Sentinel University is extending **South Texas College** benefits to immediate family members including spouse and/or children of -**South Texas College** affiliates.

6. Communication and Promotion

American Sentinel University provides a comprehensive marketing approach aimed at helping meet the educational initiatives of our partners. Through cooperation with **South Texas College's** designated internal contact, a customized communication plan will be developed and executed, which may include the following:

- The creation of a special partner website describing the educational benefits and programs available to **South Texas College** affiliates (link made available to share).
- Program launch communications regarding the affiliation to share with staff and students.
- Printed and digital collateral customized for distribution to faculty and staff.
- South Texas College student recognition and subject matter expert features developed by American Sentinel University in the form of articles, webinars, e-books or blog posts showcasing the accomplishments of South Texas College affiliates.
- Content developed by American Sentinel University (career articles, webinars, etc.) made available to **South Texas College** for repurposing or utilization as desired.
- Agreed upon site-visits to **South Texas College** (meet-and-greet, education fair attendance, etc.).
- Dedicated Account Manager and Admissions Advisor ensuring optimal levels of program support.
- Regular meetings with senior leadership to evaluate program and discuss emerging needs.

7. Termination

If this relationship terminates for any reason, American Sentinel University will maintain special tuition rates for all **South Texas College** affiliates who are students in good standing at the time of termination. Thirty (30)_day tuition deferment, per -Section 3 above, if applicable, will cease at time of termination. Students are responsible for paying their tuition and fees.
