The requirements reflected are for the core, college, major, and minor. Core completion at a Texas public institution equals core completion at SFA; however, the college, major, and minor requirements must still be completed. College requirements are indicated within the first two years by Note 7.

Any courses taken at the junior/community college level that are acceptable in the major will be substituted in; additional junior/senior level classes may be required to meet the required minimum number of upper level hours. Determination of course substitutions within the major will be made on a case-by-case basis. A maximum of 66 hours of academic courses plus up to 4 hours of PHED/KINE courses from community colleges can be applied in a bachelor's degree. If core is not complete at Texas public junior/community college, core must be completed using SFA's requirements.
