- Note 1: Eight hours (two courses) from Life & Physical Sciences Core
- Note 2: Three hours from Creative Arts Core
- Note 3: Three hours from Math Core
- Note 4: Three hours from Lang, Phil, & Culture; BA degrees require an additional course from the Lang, Phi, & Culture Core with a different course prefix from the Core course taken.
- Note 5: All BA degrees require foreign language proficiency through SFA level 232 of the same language or American Sign Language (SPH).
- Note 6: Three hours from Social & Behavioral Science Core
- Note 7: Eighteen hours from PBA 305, 400, 405, 410, 420, 470, 475, or PSC 313, 338, 447 (no more than six hours from PSC courses)
- Note 8: This course is designated as a College Requirement and can be completed either at the junior/community college or at SFA

The requirements reflected are for the core, college, major, and minor. Core completion at a Texas public institution equals core completion at SFA; however, the college, major, and minor requirements must still be completed. College requirements are indicated within the first two years by Note 8.

Any courses taken at the junior/community college level that are acceptable in the major will be substituted in; additional junior/senior level classes may be required to meet the required minimum number of upper level hours. Determination of course substitutions within the major will be made on a case-by-case basis. A maximum of 66 hours of academic courses plus up to 4 hours of PHED/KINE courses from community colleges can be applied in a bachelor's degree. If core is not complete at Texas public junior/community college, core must be completed using SFA's requirements.
