



## Articulation Agreement Between South Texas College and Texas State University

This agreement between South Texas College (STC) and Texas State University (TSU) is intended to permit (a) students who earn an associate degree at STC to transfer previously identified credits for their general education course curriculum courses freely to TSU to apply toward undergraduate degrees there, (b) permit students enrolled in undergraduate programs at TSU to easily identify general education courses available to them at STC that will fulfill their degree requirements at TSU, and (c) permit students who complete their associate degree requirements at STC and meet general and programmatic admission requirements in place at TSU at the time of their entry to complete their baccalaureate degree requirements in the same time period as an undergraduate students whose entire program is taken TSU.

The specific general education courses listed in Attachment 1 are freely transferable between STC and TSU, subject only to the limitation that TSU will apply to a specific degree program no more than 66 hours of transfer work from any accredited junior college.

Officials of STC and TSU are committed to developing detailed articulation agreements for undergraduate degree programs covering not only the general education core curriculum courses, but also other courses in associate degree programs. Detailed transfer planning guides may be approved in the future by the vice presidents or other designated officials of each institution. In all cases the goals of these agreements are to provide students with the most convenient possible articulation between the institutions and to promote the academic quality of each program.

Representatives of STC and TSU will confer on at least an annual basis to evaluate the success of this agreement and to consider any requests for amendments. Amendments may be approved by the appropriate designees at each institution.

Any other modifications to these agreements may be made following one year's written notice from either institution.
